## IMPORTANT NOTICE

- We will be unable to accept entries without the relevant fee sent with the entry. Payments by direct transfer are preferable and our bank details are included within this invitation. If paying by cheque please make payable to “ELITE SPORTS ACADEMY”.
- We will be unable to accept any entries not sent on the official entry form, received late, and/or incomplete. Late entries will not be accepted and there will be no entries on the day of competition.
- ALL details should be included regarding each competitor relevant to their category(ies), **grade, weight where relevant and date of birth**. Please don't put us in an awkward position by having to refuse your entry and please DO NOT put competitors into events that they are not eligible for.
- Coaches and parents please keep children under control and do not allow them to cause a nuisance to other Leisure Centre users. Coaches need to be aware that if any member of their delegation is found to be creating problems this may jeopardise their team's entry and, worse case scenario, earn a shikkaku for their squad.

**Students can ONLY enter categories in their age group.**

## KUMITE RULES

- Gum shields and red and blue WKF style hand mitts are compulsory for all competitors.
- WKF style shin protectors and foot pads are compulsory for 10yrs & over and advisory for under 10yrs.
- Chest guards for females are advisable. Groin guards are optional but must be one piece.
- All competitors must supply their own red and blue belts.
- WKF body protection is optional.
- Gi's must be white and the correct fit. Sleeves and trousers must not be rolled up.
- 9yrs & Under - 60 seconds : No contact to the face/head/neck with any techniques, up to 10cm scoring distance from the face/head. Win by getting 6 points clear.

- 13yrs & Under - 90 seconds : No contact to the face/head/neck with any techniques, up to 10cm scoring distance from the face/head. Win by getting 8 points clear.
- Team Kumite - may be composed from 2,3 or 4 competitors
- No repechage

## **KATA RULES**

- Categories for grade 10th-7th Kyu - Kata permitted list : Junino Kata, Tenno Kata, Taikyoku Shodan or similar beginners kata from your style, Heian / Pinan / Geki-sai, will be allowed to repeat the same kata
- Categories Open Grade - FREE KATA and must alternate between at least two kata except categories for Children 7yrs & Under ;
- Individual Kata Categories to have both competitors perform simultaneously.
- Pairs Kata : will be allowed to repeat the same kata.
- In Kata competition safety glasses or spectacles may be worn at the competitor's own risk.
- In categories Open Grade can participate also competitors from 10th-7th Kyu categories.
- No repechage.

## **KICKMASTER RULES**

- This consists of each competitor simultaneously attacking their respective red or blue kick post. The competitor who is judged to have attacked with the most skill will be awarded the win. All Karate techniques can be used. Three flag system as in kata.
- Time: 30 seconds
- Red & blue mitts compulsory
- Shin foot protectors optional
- Putting down the dummy opponent ( karate bag ) will result in loss not disqualification.

## IMPORTANT Rules for Coaches, Parents & Spectators

- Entry to this competition is on the understanding that ALL parents and students accept the following rules. If you do not agree, or think them unreasonable then speak to the organiser BEFORE the event and BEFORE submitting entries.
- Entry to the event is on the understanding that the organisers and owners of the venue accept no responsibility or liability for any injury or loss that may result from or arise from the event.
- It is the responsibility of instructors to make sure entrants are put into correct the category. **Mistakes cannot be rectified on the day.**
- Coaches must be 16 years or over and wear an official tracksuit at all times.
- Each club entering will be allocated a maximum 2 free coach passes – no exceptions.
- It is the responsibility of the coach to ensure entrants have a valid licence and insurance.
- Competitors enter this competition at their own risk and by doing so agree to absolve the ORGANIZER of any claims which may arise due to injury, loss or damage.
- Parents & Spectators CANNOT approach any of the officials tables UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. ( Please speak to your club coach who will notify the necessary people ).
- **NO PROTEST** will be allowed concerning referees decisions by **ANYONE**, under **ANY** circumstances. The competition is run in good faith and we'll all be doing our very best throughout the day!
- Any discourteous behaviour towards other competitors / officials / parents **WILL** result in disqualification from this and future events.
- Infringements of any of these rules may lead to competitors / teams being disbarred from this and future events.
- Students / Parents and Coaches are asked to **KNOW THE RULES** and respect the spirit of them.
