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IMPORTANT NOTES

INSTRUCTORS, PLEASE COMMUNICATE THE FOLLOWING TO YOUR PARENTS/COMPETITORS/SUPPORTERS.

TIMING: Registration opens **9.30am**. **KATA** events will commence at **10.00am** prompt followed by the **KUMITE** categories. Competitors who are only participating in the Kumite events do not need to arrive prior to **11.00am (juniors/cadets)** and **12 Noon (seniors)**.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Sunday 6th October, 2019. Entries will be capped at 250. No entries on the day. Sorry, no refunds.
NB Should the 250 cap be reached prior to the entry deadline date, entries will be closed early. Please submit your entry form early to avoid disappointment.

ENTRY FORM: The entry form is included in this pack. **Please email your completed entry forms to kdf.sec@gmail.com.** Entries will be confirmed by return email upon receipt of your completed form and full payment.

PAYMENT: Entry fees must be received **in advance** of the event.

CATEGORIES: In the event of low category entries, or indeed an excess of entrants, the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate/alter categories to maintain the integrity of the competition.
It is the responsibility of coaches to ensure that all competitors are registered on the day and are in the correct categories.

Kumite: Competitors must compete in their correct grade/height category. Competitors may enter a higher grade category should they so wish, however, please clearly note on the entry form if the competitor is fighting up a category. In the event that the organisers receive challenges to any entries on the day, height checks will be made and the organisers cannot guarantee to enter the competitor in an alternative category.

Juniors: No contact to the head, face or neck with punches or kicks.

Cadets: Kicks that lightly touch the head or face will be scored. Punches to these areas must be pulled short.

Seniors: 18 years + controlled contact.

Kata: Belt/grade appropriate kata must be performed. Anyone wishing to perform a higher grade kata must enter the appropriate grade category for that kata. Younger students will perform kata simultaneously.

Competitor Registration Will be carried out on the mats prior to each category starting. Please ensure your competitors are checked in promptly on the correct area. Categories and areas will be announced via the sound system prior to the start of each category.

RULES: WKF Rules apply. WKF style mitts & gum shields are compulsory, shin instep and footpads optional, groin guards and chest protectors are recommended.

REFEREES: The competition will be officiated by a team of qualified officials. Referees/Judges decisions are final. Parents/spectator must **NOT** approach any officials on the day. Please speak to your club coach directly with any issues so that they can liaise with the organisers. Discourteous or aggressive behaviour towards competitors/officials/other parents will result in disqualification from this and future events.

LICENCES/INSURANCE: All individuals, parents/guardians, coaches, clubs and associations are required to ensure that competitors hold a current valid licence and insurance and by submitting the entry form, affirm that they have seen all registrations including insurance cover for their competitors.

COACH DRESS CODE / PASSES: Coaches must wear association tracksuits and clearly display their coaching pass which will be issued on the day. Coach passes will be included in your entry pack available on the day and should be worn at all times. Please indicate how many coach passes you will require on the entry form (max 3 per club). Only 1 coach per area at any one time.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND RECORDING: Action/podium shots of the competitors will be recorded/taken for promotional purposes.

PARKING: Free parking is available at the venue but the car park will be very busy, parking is also available in the surrounding streets. Vehicles and their contents are left at the owner's risk and we will not accept any liability for damage, theft or fines. Please give yourself plenty of time to park and reach the venue.

FIRST AID: Qualified first aiders will be present at the event.

Entry to this event is on the understanding that the organiser and/or owner of the venue accepts no responsibility or liability for any injury or loss that may result from the event.

This competition is open to members of the English Karate Federation or members of other WKF affiliated national governing bodies and competitors not in contravention of WKF statute 21.9 only. Licence checks will be carried out on the day and competitors are reminded that a valid EKF licence must be presented upon request of the organising body or its representative, failure to do so may result in entry being denied.
