Undue Pressure

I want to apologise to any member who has been pressured to sign a petition that's doing the rounds and which has been instigated by the suspended directors.

In recent newsletters I've tried to explain the Board's position on the matter, but unlike the suspended directors who can say anything about the circumstances of their suspension other Board members have their hands tied because they are adhering to the letter of the law.

I want people to know that the petition is absolutely nothing to do with good governance it's quite simply a way that the suspended members believe they can interrupt the suspension process and has purely personal motives and in no way serves the interest of the EKF and its members.

The three suspended directors are trying to dig themselves out of a hole of their own making where they carried out an act without any mandate from the Board, which is why all the other Board members voted for the suspension.

I attended the recent BKF championships where, even though suspended board members had refereeing roles to fulfil, they were active whilst occupying these positions to further their petition - which I personally find disgraceful and an abuse of their positions.

So, again, I want to apologise if you are receiving phone calls or emails about this, but it's not the fault of the EKF Board.
